

On January 23rd, some hearty souls from the council served another tasty dinner at Shalom House. Some seminarians came along to help serve the meal and wash dishes.





**Church Fathers** 



Ignatius of Antioch (died c. 108/140) also known as Ignatius Theophorus, was an early Christian writer and Patriarch of Antioch. Nothing is known of Ignatius' life apart from the words of his letters and later traditions. It is said Ignatius converted to Christianity at a young age. Tradition identifies him and his friend Polycarp as disciples of John the Apostle. Later, Ignatius was chosen to serve as Bishop of Antioch; the fourth-century Church historian Eusebius writes that Ignatius succeeded Evodius. Theodoret of Cyrrhus claimed that St. Peter himself left directions that Ignatius be appointed to this episcopal see. \*Wikipedia

## Knights of Columbus Surpasses \$100 Million Milestone of Support for Seminarians, Postulants and Novices

New Haven, Conn. — The Knights of Columbus announced that its local councils have helped to donate more than \$100 million directly to seminarians, postulants and novices through its Refund Support Vocations Program (RSVP). Launched in 1981 in response to a growing vocations crisis in North America, RSVP encourages Knights to stand in solidarity with men and women pursuing religious vocations by providing financial, moral and spiritual support. Last year, more than 2,700 local councils donated \$4.1 million, an all-time high since the program began.

"For more than 40 years, RSVP has supported tens of thousands of men and women as they answer the Lord's call to serve the Church and the people of God," said Supreme Knight Patrick Kelly. He continued, "Our support for vocations speaks to the love Knights of Columbus have for the Eucharist, our parishes, and the Church."
